The Managing Directors recognise that some of its activities and operations may have an impact upon the environment and that environmental issues are of critical importance.

This Policy states the commitment of the Managing Directors of Gearing Plant Hire Ltd to continuous environmental improvement to be environmentally friendly, to demonstrate sound environmental performance, to take preventative measures in reducing pollution and take action that will lead to environmental sustainability. - 6) Encourage all persons and organisations, and organisations with which Gearing Plant Hire Ltd has contact, to become environmentally aware and environmentally responsible.
